DECISION ON THE EXTENSION OF THE PROVISIONAL APPLICATION OF GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING AN APPRAISAL EXERCISE WITH REGARDS TO THE RENEWAL OF CONTRACTS

THE ACTING ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR OF EUROJUST,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials (hereinafter referred to as "Staff Regulations") and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities (hereinafter referred to as "CEOS"), laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 259/68, and in particular to Article 43 of the Staff Regulations and to Articles 8, 15(2), 85 and 87(1) of the CEOS;

Having regard to Council Decision of 28 February 2002 setting up Eurojust with a view to reinforcing the fight against serious crime ((2002/187/JHA), hereinafter referred to as the "Eurojust Decision"), and in particular to Article 30 thereto,

Having regard to the Rules of Procedure of Eurojust (2002/C 286/01) and in particular to Article 25 thereto,

Whereas:

A general Implementing Rule on the yearly appraisal exercise and a new updated decision for implementing an appraisal exercise with regards to the renewal of contracts currently ongoing, it is advisable, in order to ensure legal certainty, to extend the application to Eurojust of the *EJ Decision on the General Provisions for Implementing an Appraisal Exercise with regards to the Renewal of Contracts* of 19 December 2005;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The application of the "*Decision on the General Provisions for Implementing an Appraisal Exercise with regards to the Renewal of Contracts*" of 19 December 2005 shall be extended until the entry into force of a new decision on the appraisal exercise with regards to the renewal of contracts.

Article 2

Article 8 shall be replaced as follows: "These provisions shall apply to the appraisals for the renewal of the contract to be conducted for agents whose contracts end in 2008".

Article 3

The Decision shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
