

**Opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust on
the draft Memorandum of Understanding between**

Eurojust

and

**the European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT
systems in the area of freedom, security and justice (eu-LISA)**

On 13 October 2016 the Joint Supervisory Body was invited by Eurojust to give its opinion on the draft Memorandum of Understanding between the European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT systems in the area of freedom, security and justice (eu-LISA) and Eurojust, in accordance with Article 26(2) of the Eurojust Decision.

The Joint Supervisory Body welcomed the draft Memorandum of Understanding between Eurojust and eu-LISA and in particular the wording used in its Article 2(2) which provides that the *“Exchange of information or experience provided for in this Memorandum of Understanding shall not include the transmission of operational information including data relating to an identified or identifiable person”*. Accordingly, the draft Memorandum does not include any legal basis to exchange personal data.

The Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust issues therefore a positive opinion regarding this Memorandum of Understanding.
