Opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust on the draft Memorandum of Understanding between **Eurojust**

and

the European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT systems in the area of freedom, security and justice (eu-LISA)

On 13 October 2016 the Joint Supervisory Body was invited by Eurojust to give its opinion on the draft Memorandum of Understanding between the European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT systems in the area of freedom, security and justice (eu-LISA) and Eurojust, in accordance with Article 26(2) of the Eurojust Decision.

The Joint Supervisory Body welcomed the draft Memorandum of Understanding between Eurojust and eu-LISA and in particular the wording used in its Article 2(2) which provides that the "Exchange of information or experience provided for in this Memorandum of Understanding shall not include the transmission of operational information including data relating to an identified or identifiable person". Accordingly, the draft Memorandum does not include any legal basis to exchange personal data.

The Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust issues therefore a positive opinion regarding this Memorandum of Understanding.
