

Executive Board meeting 20 January 2025

Summary of outcomes

The Chair of the Executive Board, Mr Michael Schmid, opened the meeting and welcomed the members to the second meeting in 2025 of the Executive Board of Eurojust.

Main discussions

The Executive Board took note of the decision of the Advisory Group on Organisational Development to close the 2024 project for a new prioritisation process as of the beginning of the 2026 planning cycle. The Executive Board took note of the request by the Advisory Group on Organisational Development to the Administration to, by the end of 2025, carry out and present a final assessment for the whole 2026 planning cycle.

The Executive Board reviewed the draft Single Programming Document 2026-2028, including the draft budget and establishment plan 2026.

The Executive Board decided to accept the request to participate in the 'Identification study for two global projects on air-sea trafficking and criminal justice'.
