

Executive Board meeting 7 July 2025 Summary of outcomes

The Chair of the Executive Board, Mr Michael Schmid, opened the meeting and welcomed the members to the fourteenth meeting in 2025 of the Executive Board of Eurojust.

Main decisions

The Executive Board discussed a proposal of the Cybercrime Working Group to prioritise the work on the e-evidence legislative package. The Executive Board took note of the state of play of the SIRIUS project and its activities related to the e-evidence package.

The Executive Board discussed a proposal from the Advisory group on organisational development to establish a project on Artificial Intelligence.

The Executive Board approved the draft action plan for implementation of the revised National Desk Assistants (NDA) model.

The Executive Board approved the proposed modifications of Eurojust's internal administrative structures for implementation in Q3-Q4 2025, in accordance with Article 16(3)(e) of the Eurojust Regulation. The Executive Board supported the launch of phase II based on the long term vision (Vision 2035) exercise.
