Key findings



The 2024 request volume is about 3.5 times the volume of the base-year 2018, totalling 303,289 requests measured in this sample. This is an increase of about 249%.



The success rate of EU requests in 2024 was at 76% in this sample – the best result since the first edition of the report.



Google and Meta receive the most requests – together they make up 82% of the total volume or 249,867 requests in this sample.



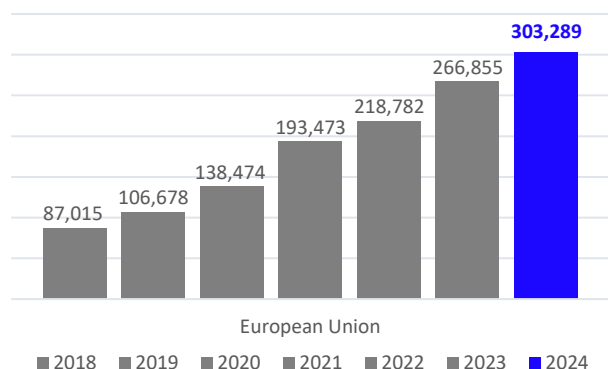
The volume of emergency disclosure requests issued by EU competent authorities has increased by 977% since 2018. From 2023 to 2024, it jumped by 32% to 28,608 requests measured in this sample.

Recommendations

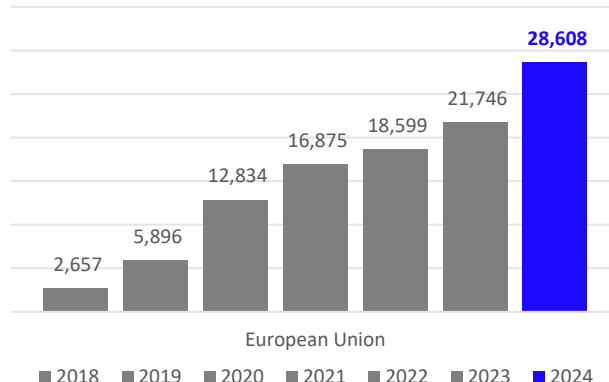
- Assess the final readiness for the launch of the decentralised IT system of the EU Electronic Evidence legislative package from a service provider perspective

Emergency EU data requests to selected service providers (2018 to 2024)



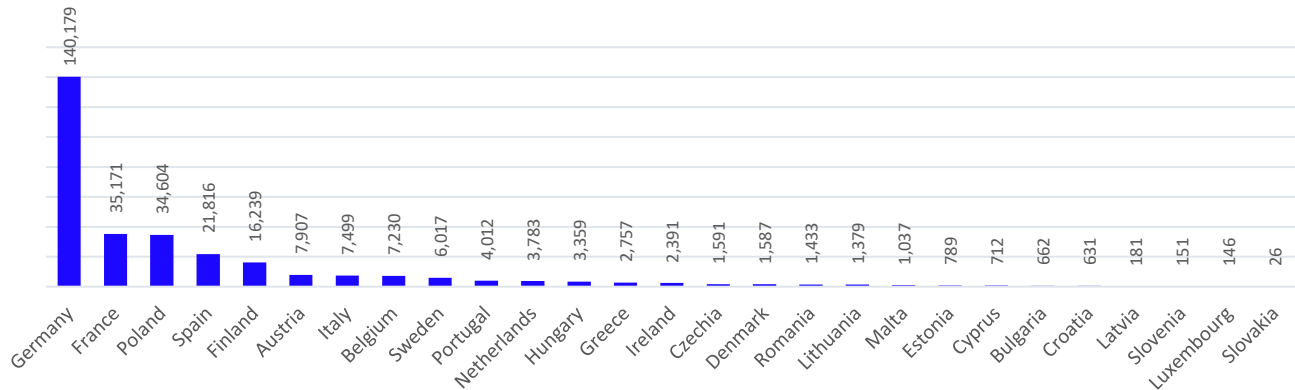

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Requests per MSs

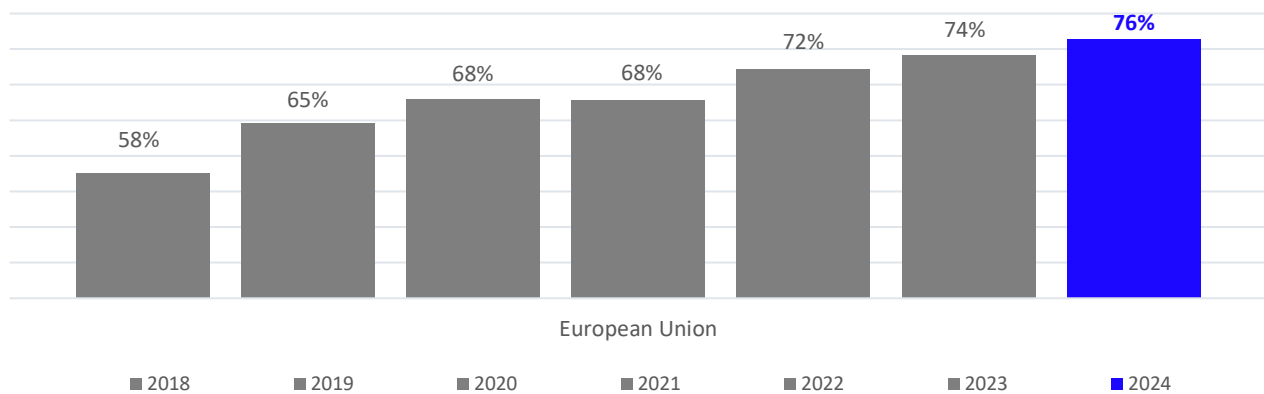
EU Member States' data requests to selected service providers in 2024

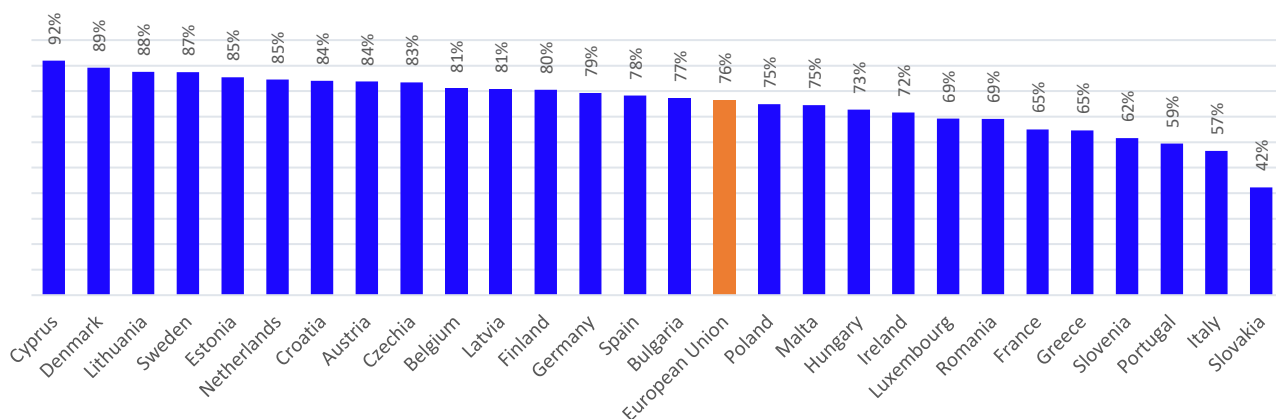
Success rates
