

Funding Joint investigation teams

Providing technical and financial support to JITs is part of Eurojust's mission to stimulate and improve the coordination of investigations and prosecutions in cross-border criminal cases. This funding programme ensures that financial and other organisational constraints linked to the cross-border nature of a case do not hinder the establishment and operational needs of a JIT.



Who can apply?

- Judicial and/or law enforcement authorities
- JITs between EU States and JITs between EU/non-EU States
- Eurojust's National Members invited to participate in the JIT

- ✗ Purchase of equipment
- ✗ Pre-financing of costs

Costs of cross-border operations

- ✓ Travel and accommodation
- ✓ Interpretation and translation
- ✓ Transport of evidence/seized items

Logistical support

- ✓ Logistical support
- ✓ Loan of smartphones, laptops, mobile scanners & printers
- ✓ Communication costs included

PROCESS

FILL IN THE FORM



- Upload and use latest version
- Include needs of all JIT partners
- Date, sign and initial each page

How to submit

- Send scanned form to jits@eurojust.europa.eu
- Attach JIT agreement, extensions and financial identification form (FIF)
- Submit within fifteen-day set period

Evaluation and Award

- Evaluation by Eurojust staff and practitioners
- Decision within 15 days

Action

Planned actions to be performed in three-month period

- Send form and supported documents to jits@eurojust.europa.eu
- Within one month after end of action period
- Individual claims by each institution/agency (no natural persons)
