### SCALE OF THE CHALLENGE



Prosecutors from across the EU turned to Eurojust for support in cross-border criminal investigations involving:

**89 438** suspects

**2 292** cases involving organised crime groups

**€ 17.3 bn** in damages

**375 171** victims of crime
