What is covered

Costs of cross-border operations

- Travel and accommodation
- Interpretation and translation
- Transportation costs for transferring items
- Specialist expertise
- Purchase of low value equipment
- Loan of smartphones, laptops, mobile scanners & printers, including communication costs

Complete the application

- Standard funding: complete and submit via JITs Portal
- Urgent funding: submit Application Form and Budget Estimate via email

Evaluation and Award

- Evaluated by Evaluation Committee
- Standard funding: decision within 15 days
- Urgent funding: decision within 5 days



When to submit

- Standard funding: within one of the eight Calls for proposals published approximately every 45 days
- Urgent funding: a request can be submitted when the operational need arises

Action

Standard funding: planned actions to be performed in three-month period Possibility to request an extension of the action period Urgent funding: planned actions to be performed within 14 calendar days No possibility for extension

Claim

- Send form and supporting documents to jits@eurojust.europa.eu
- Within one month after end of action period
 Individual claims by each institution/agency (no natural persons)
