

Executive Board meeting 18 May 2020

Summary of outcomes

The chair of the Executive Board, Mr Ladislav Hamran, opened the meeting and welcomed the members to the seventh meeting of the Executive Board of Eurojust.

Main decisions

The Executive Board reviewed the Single Programming Document 2022-2024 preparatory documents: General Context, Assumptions, Annual Activities/Objectives.

The Executive Board took note of the European Court of Auditors preliminary observations “Future of EU Agencies – Potential for more flexibility and cooperation” and decided to launch a written procedure requesting its members to approve the draft Eurojust reply to the European Court of Auditors and to the EU Agencies Shared Support Office.

The Executive Board decided to launch a written procedure requesting its members to approve the Executive Board Decision adopting the charter of tasks and responsibilities of Eurojust’s accounting officer.

The Executive Board provided guidance on the organisation of large events by Eurojust in 2020.

The Executive Board decided to submit to the College for approval a United States request to continue the partnership in the area of battlefield information, through an initiative aimed at approving the search process of existing battlefield information to ensure its use and admissibility in the courts of the EU Member States.

The Executive Board took note of the Genocide Network Report on cumulative prosecution of foreign terrorist fighters for core international crimes and terrorism-related offences and decided to distribute it to the College, for further dissemination to the national authorities.
